## Key Components

- **Bill Writing** – Each Delegate will write a bill which, in their opinion, makes the state of Alabama a better place to live. This bill will be written prior to the conference and submitted online.
- **Committee Meetings** – Every Delegate will be assigned to a committee with about 20 other students with a similar bill topic. Each committee member will get a chance to present their bill to the rest of the committee so that it has a fair chance to advance to the legislative session.
- **Legislative Sessions** – Each delegate is assigned to either the House of Representatives or the Senate. These groups meet in the Statehouse Chambers and debate the bills that have made it out of committee. Everyone who attends has an opportunity to be called on to speak.
- **Speeches and Elections** – Officers for next year’s conference will be elected and appointed by the end of this year’s conference. The officers help plan and execute the conference and meet regularly throughout the year.
